The Accessibility Policy of Grandville Avenue Arts & Humanities is as follows:

The Cook Arts Center is wheelchair accessible, and we make sure our programs are accessible to students of all abilities. In our weekly pottery workshops for adult students from the Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired, our instructor is skilled at helping students visualize their creations with their hands. Although we have yet to encounter a hearing-impaired student, we will secure the services of a signer when the need arises. We ensure that our instructors and volunteers make special provisions for students with cognitive and/or learning disabilities. Finally, we address the language barrier by providing bilingual marketing materials and by securing Spanish-speaking and interpreters as needed.
